

Apache Junction Performing Arts Center

Technical Packet

1. AUDITORIUM

- The Performing Arts Center was built in 1991.
- The seating capacity is 640 with 10 additional wheelchair accessible seating.
- The Performing Arts Center has one load in point. It is located in the back of the auditorium; the load in point is at ground level.
- Loading doors from the loading area to the scene shop and to stage left are 16 feet long and 10 feet wide.

2. DRESSING ROOMS

- The Performing Arts Center has two chorus (group) dressing rooms, one men's dressing room and one women's dressing room.
- Both dressing rooms have mirrors, sinks, wardrobe racks and one single stall restroom.
- The dressing rooms are located directly behind the stage between the scene shop and the choir classroom.

3. COMMUNICATION

- The Performing Arts Center uses telex intercom headset for communication. All headsets and belt packs are in good condition. All stations have two channel lines that can be party lined or isolated. There are nine locations where headset communication can be accessed with both channels:
 1. Downstage Right
 2. Downstage Left
 3. Men's Dressing Room
 4. Women's Dressing Room
 5. Catwalk
 6. Sound Booth
 7. Lighting Booth
 8. Follow Spot
 9. Lobby
- The Performing Arts Center has monitors in both the men's and women's dressing rooms.
- The headset system uses XLR 3-pin cables

4. VIDEO

- The Performing Arts Center has one video projector available. It is located up in the lighting/sound booth. It is an Epson EB-G5650. It's mainly used for business presentations.
- There are two ways to connect to the projector, one is in the lighting/sound booth and the other is on stage right next to the main curtain.
- The projector connects VGA only.

5. FLY SYSTEM AND RIGGING

- The Performing Arts Center has a manual counterweight fly system.
- There are 26 line sets including all electrics, drapery and batons.
- Please check the Batten Schedule for open and used line sets.
- The Grand Curtain is grey, all legs and borders are black
- The cyclorama is white and is 36 feet wide.

6. ELECTRICAL

- The Performing Arts Center has 156 dimmers at 20 amps in the dimmer rack.
- Each dimmer is wired to one circuit in the field
- The Cyc lights are on a relay switch and are not to be removed.
- The Performing Arts Center has an ETC Element Console.
- The Performing Arts Center has One ETC Sensor 3 dimmer rack.
- Lighting inventory is available upon request.
- The Performing Arts Center has four electrics.
- There are four floor pockets; two offstage right and two offstage left.
- The Performing Arts Center has one Supertrooper follow spot.

7. SOUND SYSTEM

- The Performing Arts Center has a mono array system.
- The Performing Arts Center has a Yamaha TF5 Console.
- The Performing Arts Center has one digital snake: Tio 1608-D
- The Performing Arts Center has both wired and wireless microphones. Microphone list are available on request.
