

Hybrid Model Overview

The Hybrid Model is available for students from September 8 through September 25, depending on community health metrics. It is anticipated that the AJUSD Governing Board will allow for in-person school for all AJUSD schools to begin October 12.

Overview of Hybrid Model

- 2 days a week in person / 3 days a week online
- Students will be cohorted (like in the learning lab)
- General Education / Special Education Students
- Safety Precautions in Place
- PPE (masks, face shields, gloves)
- Sanitizing / Social Distancing
- Limited movement on campus

Hybrid Specific Elementary Systems

- Transportation is provided for those who typically ride the bus
- Students will report directly to the classroom each morning
- Recess breaks by cohorts
- Lunch time with cohort class
- Limited movement around the campus
- Limited visitors to the classroom
- Educational opportunities to teach students proper procedures for washing hands, wear a mask, and social distancing when walking with others

Hybrid Specific Secondary Systems

- Transportation is provided for those who typically ride the bus
- Students will report directly to first period classroom when they arrive on campus
- Signage on campus to direct the flow of students/foot traffic
- No groups of students socializing together
- Phased cafeteria opening, reduced number of students in the cafeteria
- Continued phasing of Fall Athletics
- Modified Performing Arts practices/performances

Temperature checks will be taken on all campuses as students arrive. Prior to sending your child to school in the morning, does your child have ANY ONE of the following?
